The Haslers Foundation was established by Haslers Chartered Accountants in 2008 and became a Charity Commission-registered charity in 2013. Since 2008, it has provided more than £150,000 of support to national and local good causes.

Haslers Foundation: About our organisation

Our key objectives are:

- prevent or relieve poverty and financial hardship by providing grants and services to people in need or to charities or other organisations involved in this type of work
- support people who are ill or have long-term medical conditions and initiatives to preserve good health
- supporting recreational, leisure, education and other activities to help young people participate in society as mature, responsible individuals.

The areas in which The Foundation operates include Essex, Hertfordshire, London and Middlesex.
